
Western Australia Return to pre-lockdown rules

The WA government has confirmed that the post-lockdown transition rules for Perth and the Peel region will cease at 12.01am on 14 February 2021.

This Advice was developed to keep Members informed of the restrictions applied to the metropolitan Perth, Peel and South West Regions for 5 days with effect from 6pm on 31 January 2021. It has now been updated to reflect the government confirmation that the transition rules will cease at 12.01am on 14 February 2021.



UPDATE 13 FEBRUARY 2021

The WA government has confirmed that the post-lockdown transition restrictions for Perth and the Peel Region will cease at 12.01am on 14 February 2021. Key messages:

- Masks will no longer be required to be worn inside or outside (it is not clear at this stage whether the wearing of masks in airports will still be required).
- There will be no travel restrictions other than for remoted Aboriginal communities.
- Capacity restrictions that were in place prior to the lockdown will be in place, pending ongoing health advice.
- Mandatory contact registration will continue, as was planned prior to the lockdown.
