



NSW – Northern Rivers Restrictions Lifted

With effect from 11.59pm on 5 April 2021, the temporary restrictions for the Northern Rivers, encompassing Byron Bay, Tweed, Lismore and Ballina Local Government Areas have been lifted.

INTRODUCTION

This Advice has been developed to keep Members informed of the restrictions imposed due to recent cases of COVID-19 in northern New South Wales. With restrictions now lifted, this will be the last update of this Advice.

The Public Health (COVID-19 Northern Rivers) Order 2021 that commenced at 5pm on 31 March 2021 was [revoked](#) with effect from 11.59pm on 5 April 2021. The Northern Rivers area will now return to the restrictions that apply across New South Wales.
