Why conduct a review of your Pandemic Plan?

Management systems (documents and

procedures) - This requires a wider scope and addresses organisational structures, COVID-19 planning activities, responsibilities, implemented processes, review cycles and measurement and evaluation issues.

What a Pandemic (COVID-19) Plan review will tell you:

- If you have effective processes in place to comply with the health and safety legislation and government guidelines including COVIDSafe business plan requirements;
- Whether your business leaders and workers are meeting the standards which the company has set itself within its pandemic plan;
- Critical risks that need immediate attention;
- Critque on COVID-19 prevention measures against best practice appropriate to your industry;
- Contingency measures you require in the event of another outbreak; and
- Opportunities for improvement with recommendations to improve business performance and results.

What you'll get:

- Understanding of the suitability and appropriateness of your formal and documented systems for managing the risks associated with a pandemic;
- Identification of any significant health and safety liabilities associated with activities undertaken to minimise infection risks and promote mental health; and
- A prioritised personalised Pandemic Safety Action Plan.
