Call to Action

Large public companies worldwide are under pressure to decarbonise their business and eliminate carbon from their supply chains. As this pressure increases all businesses, large and small, will need a clear understanding of their own carbon footprint and have in place a strategy to reduce and achieve Net Zero.

To help Australian small-medium enterprises (SMEs) prepare for their Net Zero journey, the Entrepreneurs' Programme are delivering a Net Zero SMART Supply Chain project. Curated by Entrepreneurs' Programme Growth Facilitator Kate Brooks, the project kicked off in Perth in October 2021.

Kate notes, "We are working with 18 Perth-based business over the coming year to help them progress their Net Zero business goal by providing access to industry networks, expert resources and up to \$20,000 (matched) grant funding."

With this is mind, the project began with a series of in-person learning events for businesses with presentations from 25 local net zero & decarbonisation experts. This has built an SME Peer Group with like-minded people who are passionate about creating more sustainable businesses and seizing the net zero business opportunity.

The project involves six Entrepreneurs' Programme Growth Facilitators.
